

The Story of Shorelíne Stítchers' Showcase

Shoreline Stitchers' Showcase is a judged exhibit of needlework sponsored by Needle Artists by the Sea (NAS), a chapter of the American Needlepoint Guild (ANG), in evennumbered years. Anyone who pays the entry fee may enter needlework. The showcase is an educational event that is open to the public for viewing.

NAS sponsored the first Shoreline Stitchers' Showcase on June 3, 2006 at Loyola Marymount University in Los Angeles. Mary Fleming was the first Showcase Manager and the driving force behind starting this event. Victoria Walton designed the logo. In 2008, we held the 2nd Shoreline Stitchers' Showcase at the South Coast Botanic Garden, and we have been here ever since.

Over the years, many volunteers have put in long hours to ensure the Showcase is successful. Following months of preparation, members and friends of NAS put the display up on Thursday before the event and bring it down after the event closes on Sunday. Additional volunteers act as docents to answer questions from the public.

The Showcase is more than an exhibit of fine needlework. It is also known for its opportunity baskets and the boutique. Members and friends of NAS donate the opportunity baskets and items for the boutique.

We have enough display space for 500 entries. Of those, we judge the first 300 for which we receive entry forms. Entries may be any needlework that has been created by hand with a threaded needle.

Awards

All entries in the non-professional, professional, and master divisions are judged against a standard. All works that meet or exceed the threshold for First Place are awarded a First Place ribbon. The remaining pieces that meet or exceed a threshold for Second Place are awarded a Second Place ribbon, and similarly for Third Place and for Honorable Mention ribbons. There may be more than one First Place, Second Place, Third Place, or Honorable Mention ribbon awarded in a class, or there may be no ribbons of a particular level awarded in a class. The awarding of the ribbons is entirely up to our judges.

All judges together award the Best of Class ribbons and a Best of Show. Each judge awards a Judge's Choice ribbon. The winner of the Best of Show, Popular Choice ribbon is determined by the ballots at the show's close.

Popular Choice Best of Show

You be the judge. Please take a moment to vote for your favorite piece of needlework entered in our Showcase. Place your ballot in the ballot box at the entrance.

Ask the (Needle) Artist

While looking through the Showcase, you may have a question or two for a particular stitcher. We are providing a question box for your convenience. Look for the decorated box near the entrance, and you can pose your question directly to the stitcher. You pro-vide the entry number for the piece, your name, and a form of contact. We will get your question to the artist.

About Our Judges ...

Teresa Frank

Teresa received her Judge's Certification from the National Academy of Needlearts in 2011 and, since that time, has judged exhibits for local, state, and national venues including Woodlawn in Virginia, The Exemplary for NAN, Stan Hywet Needlework Guild Stitchery Showcase and Shoreline Stitchers' Showcase.

Teresa began stitching at an early age when her mother taught her simple embroidery stitches for embellishing a pair of butterfly-stamped pillowcases. This early embroidery lesson fueled a passion that was later nourished through self-study. Retired after 35 years in the transportation industry, Teresa has continued her education by participating in workshops, seminars, extended study programs and correspondence courses offered by EGA, ANG, Northwest Sampler Guild and National Academy of Needlearts (NAN), as well as local needlework shops.

Teresa is a past administrator for NAN's Exemplary and currently serves on NAN's Board as Secretary/Treasurer. She is past president for her local EGA and two local ANG chapters and has continued her guild involvement volunteering as Faculty Chair for two EGA GPR Region Seminars and mentoring new embroiderers.

Cíndy Gershín

Cindy Lee Gershin began her lifelong interest in needlework as a child, when her mother gave her a piece of stamped linen and some hanks of cotton floss. She became certified as an EGA Master Craftsman in Counted Thread in 1998 and has been an EGA Certified Needlework Judge since 2007. Additionally, Cindy became an ANG NeedleArts Appraiser in 2009, an ANG Master NeedleArts Appraiser in 2017, and most recently a Senior Master NeedleArts Appraiser in 2022. She has served as Vice Chairman and Chairman of ANG's NeedleArts Appraisal Program. Cindy feels the work involved in both judging and appraising complement each other in inspecting and evaluating needleart. She especially enjoys judging and sharing her knowledge, with the goal of advancing needlework to the highest level while keeping it enjoyable. She wants to share her love of creating and exhibiting needlework and wants all exhibitors to have a positive experience no matter what level embroiderer they are.

Cindy has exhibited needlework in many shows, from local to national, and has received numerous awards including several Best of Shows. She is particularly proud of having received the Princess Grace Award from ANG, and the Helen Brooks Memorial Award twice from the Shoreline Stitchers Showcase. Cindy is a member of ANG, EGA, NAN and OSCG. In addition to her love of needlework, Cindy has a degree in music from the prestigious Berklee College of Music where she studied piano and met her husband, Scott. She enjoys being with her son Jaiden whenever he looks up from his phone. Cindy has also recently rekindled her love of photography and enjoys discovering new ways to use her cameras.

Judges' Statement

Our thanks to the judging committee for the opportunity to participate in the 2024 Shoreline Stitchers' Showcase. The judging was well organized which made for a smooth transition for judging each category. We appreciate all your assistance and hospitality.

It has been a pleasure seeing and evaluating all the entrants' extraordinary work up close. With such a high quality of entries, determining Best of Class and Best of Show winners was quite a challenge. This show is known for its high level of workmanship, design, and creativity. Each piece was judged on its own merits within its category. As judges we endeavor to provide constructive comments that will encourage entrants to continue improving their work and advance needle art to a higher level.

Some issues noticed frequently this year were loose threads, inconsistent tension, overworked threads, traveling threads, cut thread ends showing from behind the ground, beads needing to be more secure on the ground, stitches that would be improved by the use of a laying tool, and threads that had untwisted while being worked. Also remember to check your work carefully before finishing or framing for missing and incorrectly worked stitches and remove stray pet hairs. The use of glass on needlework is appropriate when desired, but the use of non-glare glass detracts from the beauty of your needlework and makes it difficult to clearly see your work.

Thank you for the opportunity to serve as your judges and hope that you will continue entering your beautiful work in future shows to keep the art of needlework in the public eye.

| Non-professional | Anyone who, at the time of entry submission, engages in needlework as a pastime and for pleasure rather than for financial gain. |
| Professional | Anyone who, at the time of entry submission or previously, engages in needlework as a teacher, judge, artist/designer, lecturer, author, or stitches for commissioned work and receives payment, in any form including salary, discounts or merchandise. |
| Master | Anyone who, at the time of entry submission and previously, has been awarded any of the following in any technique represented by the Classes of this exhibit: Best of Category or Show at a regional exhibit (more than 150 entries, including county and state fairs), 1st Place at a National judged exhibit (e.g., ANG, NAN, etc.) or entry into a national juried exhibit (e.g., EGA); or ANG Master Needle Artist or EGA Master Craftsman. Once a stitcher is recognized as a Master Stitcher, any future Non-Professional Division entries from them will be listed in the Master Division. |
| Youth | Anyone who, at the time of entry submission, is 17 years or younger or currently enrolled in high school. Entries from high school students will be judged. Younger entrants will be awarded a Participant Ribbon. There are no youth entries in the 2024 Shoreline Stitchers Showcase. |
| Non-Judged | Any piece of needlework that is for display only, not to be judged and will not receive comments. |

| Original | A unique, one-of-a-kind design, interpreted within the definition of needlework from the mind and hands of the artist/stitcher to whom it is credited. An artist's statement is required for entries in this category. |
| Adaptation | A design translated or adapted from 1) a non-needlework source, 2) a design originally worked in a different needlework technique, or 3) any source over 100 years old. The adaptation may be an exact visual needlework reproduction of the original design or may contain easily recognizable elements from that design. This must be the work (adaptation and execution) of the exhibiting artist, with no help from any other person. An artist's statement is required for entries in this category. |
| Class Project | A non-original design worked with person-to-person interaction between the student and teacher, usually in a physical classroom environment (i.e., seminars, shops, chapter meetings and workshops.) This category also includes Correspondence Courses and any form of Cyber Workshop. This category includes designs that may be original but the finished product was the result of teacher-guided efforts, such as creativity or design workshops. |

| Independent | A non-original design worked without person-to-person interaction with a teacher, such as Workshop By Mail, needlework graph, chart, leaflet, line drawing or kit. |

| Needlepoint: Painted Canvas | Canvas of 24 threads per inch or fewer, with a painted or drawn design. |
| Needlepoint: Charted Design < 12" | Canvas of 24 threads per inch or fewer, worked from a charted design where the stitched area is less than 12×12 inches and less than 144 square inches. |
| Needlepoint: Charted Design <u>></u> 12″ | Canvas of 24 threads per inch or fewer, worked from a charted design where the stitched area is greater than or equal to 12 x 12 inches. |
| Petit point | Ground fabric of 22 threads per inch or greater with most of the work done over one canvas or fabric intersection. |
| Counted Thread: Sampler | Includes Cross Stitch, Hardanger, Drawn Thread, Pulled Thread, Blackwork, Assisi, etc. on either fabric or canvas, of a Sampler-type design. |
| Counted Thread: Cross Stitch | Predominantly Cross Stitch on either fabric or canvas. |
| Counted Thread: Other | Includes Cross Stitch, Hardanger, Drawn Thread, Pulled Thread, Blackwork, Assisi, etc. on either linen or canvas, any type design other than Sampler. |
| Surface Embroidery | Includes Crewel, Cutwork, Stumpwork, Smocking, etc., worked on fabric |
